



Acadience Reading Mentor Workshop Training

The one-day Acadience Reading (DIBELS Next) Mentoring workshop, brought to you by Michigan's Integrated Behavior and Learning Support Initiative (MIBLSI), has been designed for those who have already completed the Acadience Reading (DIBELS Next) Essential and Data Interpretation trainings and wish to extend their knowledge of Acadience Reading so they may provide leadership and training to others.
