



MIDATA Directions: Enter Student Risk Screening Scale

This document describes how to enter Student Risk Screening Scale results in the MIBLSI Database (MIDATA). **This task can be performed by anyone with a school user role or higher access role (district, ISD, state) in MIDATA.** Once data are entered, scores for each school will feed to the following dashboards in MIDATA:

- School dashboard: Behavior Outcomes tab
- District dashboard: Behavior Outcomes tab

Go to School-Level Data Entry

1. Go to **Data Entry** in the top menu.
2. Enter **School Name** in the text field and select the school from the dropdown menu that appears.
3. Select **School Year**.
4. Click **Select**.

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Generate your summary of SRSS results by grade

Schools are using a variety of systems for collecting and summarizing SRSS data (e.g., paper/pencil, Excel spreadsheets, google spreadsheets, local school information systems and data warehouses). Regardless of method for collecting the information, teams will need the information summarized to align with the data entry in MIDATA.

1. Enter the number of students per grade level who scored in the Low, Moderate, and High Risk categories for **Externalizing Behavior**.
2. Enter the number of students per grade level who scored in the Low, Moderate, and High Risk categories for **Internalizing Behavior**.
3. Click **Save**.
