- Provide two Learner Objectives that follow the stem statement "Participants will..." Please
 use measurable verbs such as describe, explain, identify, discuss, compare, define,
 differentiate, list
- Data Example showing student growth or improved student outcomes
- Identify focus area(s) your proposal will address. Select up to three. See MTSS Focus Area list and example below.
- Check the box if you agree to share your site's story for future communications (MDE, MiMTSS Newsletter, social media, etc.)
